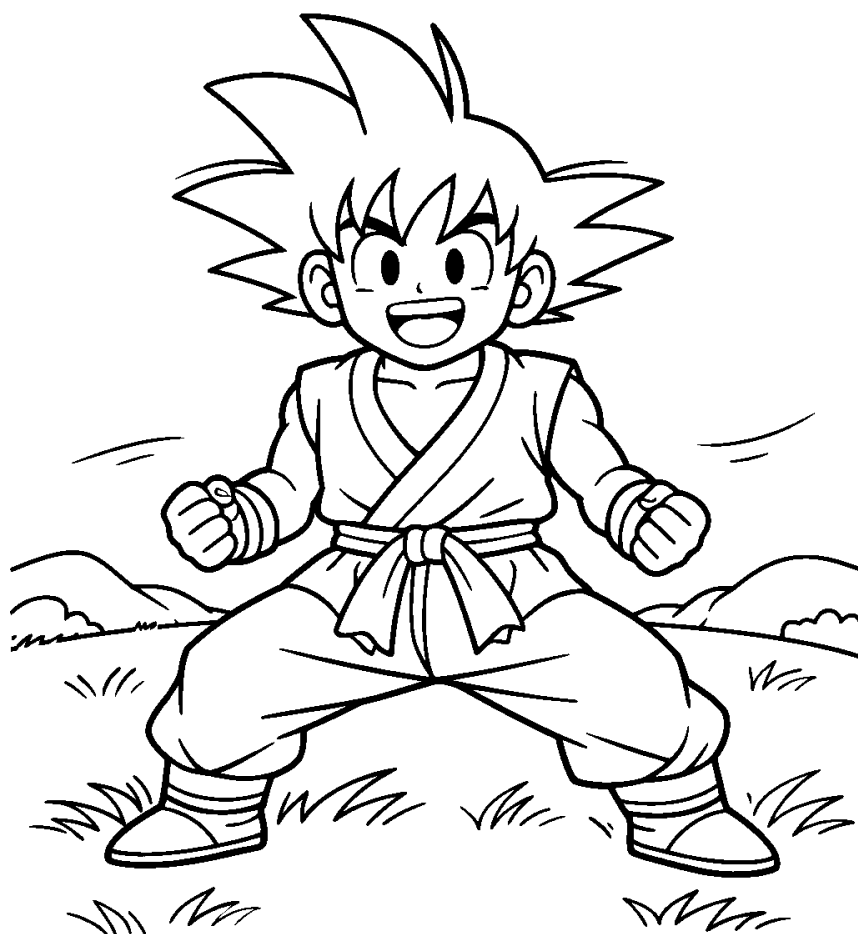

About this collection

Welcome to our Goku coloring pages: a full collection of free printable designs of the cheerful spiky haired martial artist, each one ready to download as a high quality PDF and print at home in seconds. No sign up, no watermarks: pick a page, press Download PDF, and you are coloring within a minute. Every drawing is original fan artwork in our own line style, sized for Letter and A4 paper, with bold, clear outlines that small hands can follow. You will find him firing the famous cupped hands beam across a canyon, hair standing straight up inside a swirling aura, flying through fat clouds with one fist out, meditating under a crashing waterfall and bowing at the edge of a tournament ring, plus the little flying cloud, the extending staff, the wish dragon uncoiling over the seven star orbs, a chibi version, a three panel comic page, an eight bit pixel portrait and an extra easy sheet for toddlers. No printer? Every design can also be colored online right in your browser.

Where can you print free Goku coloring pages?

Right here, free, in under a minute. This page holds 30 printable Goku coloring pages drawn in our own line style, each one a high quality PDF sized for US Letter and A4 paper. There is no sign up and no watermark, and every design can also be colored online in your browser.

Six ways to color the spiky haired warrior

The set is grouped so that no two pages feel alike. There are the forms: the calm ready stance on a grassy hilltop, hair standing straight up inside a flame shaped aura, the perfectly still silver form with energy drifting upward, the young boy version with a monkey tail and a long staff, the tight focused pose with a ring of energy at his feet and the heavy weighted vest that turns training into punishment. There is the action: the cupped hands beam roaring across a canyon, full speed flight through fat clouds, the crouching shout that lifts rocks off the ground, a side on martial arts guard, a high spinning kick with a long motion trail and a straight punch thrown at the reader. There are rides and props: the little flying cloud sailing over mountain peaks, the extending staff whipped into a whirling circle, the long wish dragon uncoiling above the orbs and an enormous turtle shell strapped to his back on a steep dirt path. There are worlds and training grounds: the waterfall, a round floating platform above a sea of clouds, the tournament ring, a wide crater of broken rock and a domed chamber where a one handed push up is a warm up. There are items for anyone who prefers coloring objects to characters: the seven star orbs in a circle, one big four star orb on a folded cloth, a handheld tracker beside two capsules and the orange uniform laid out with its sash and boots. And there are styles, from a chibi version and a three panel comic page to a star orb mandala, an eight bit pixel portrait and an extra easy sheet with very thick lines.

What is going on in these pictures

If your child knows the show they will explain all of this before the first page finishes printing, but here is the short version for everyone else. Goku is a cheerful, endlessly hungry martial artist who trains harder than anyone and would rather make a friend of a rival than beat one. The spiky hair that stands straight up, the glow around him and the cracked ground underfoot all mean the same thing: he has powered up, and he does it in stages, which is why he looks a little different from page to page. The two cupped hands at his hip are the wind up for his signature energy beam. The small yellow cloud is a flying ride only a good heart can sit on. The long red staff stretches to any length he asks for. The seven crystal orbs, each marked with a different number of stars, summon the long wish dragon when they are gathered together, and the four star one is the keepsake he grew up with.

Coloring ideas for orange gis, gold auras and crystal orbs

Two colors carry most of these pages: a strong orange for the uniform and a deep blue for the sash, wristbands and boots, which is why he still reads as himself even in pencil. Keep those big areas flat and even and spend your effort on the small stuff: the yellow boot trim, the knot of the sash and the shading under the jaw. Hair is where you get to choose. Leave it black for the everyday form, or go bright yellow with a white core for the powered up pages, or a pale silver grey for the calm one. Auras look best worked from the outside in: orange at the outer edge, yellow in the middle, and a thin band left white right against his body so he seems to glow rather than sit inside a blob. On the orb pages, lay down orange first, rub a little brown around the rim and leave one small white patch where the light hits, and the glass turns solid. On the flying and kicking pages, color the speed lines and dust a pale grey or blue instead of leaving them white and the whole drawing starts moving. Markers need thicker paper (cardstock) so they do not bleed through; crayons, pencils and gel pens are happy on plain printer paper. More advice is in our how-to-print guide.

The best page for every age

Toddlers should start with the extra easy sheet: a big smiling face, very thick lines and only a handful of shapes. Kids from about four to nine head straight for the beam, the flying page, the spinning kick and the wish dragon. Older kids and grown-ups tend to pick the star orb mandala, the three panel comic page and the eight bit pixel portrait, which color like a pattern rather than a picture and can eat a whole evening. Running a party? Print a stack of the ready stance page and hand out orange, blue and gold pencils, or print the seven orbs, cut them apart and hide them around the room for the smallest guest to find. Printing for a whole class is fine, the details are in our licensing policy.

More cartoon coloring pages

If a fast blue hedgehog is the other favorite in your house, our Sonic coloring pages run loops, rings and spin dashes in the same line style, and a plumber in a red cap brings kart racing and warp pipes to our Mario coloring pages. For another world full of creatures to catch, our Pokemon coloring pages fill a page each, and for younger colorers the Bluey coloring pages and the Hello Kitty coloring pages are gentler and just as bold. The whole cast lives together in our cartoon coloring pages hub, and if the printer is out of ink you can paint any of these in our online coloring studio.

How to print

Every page is sized for US Letter and prints on A4 without cropping if you set your printer to "fit to page". Print single-sided so colors do not show through, and use cardstock if you plan to use markers. There are no watermarks and no sign-up, on any page.

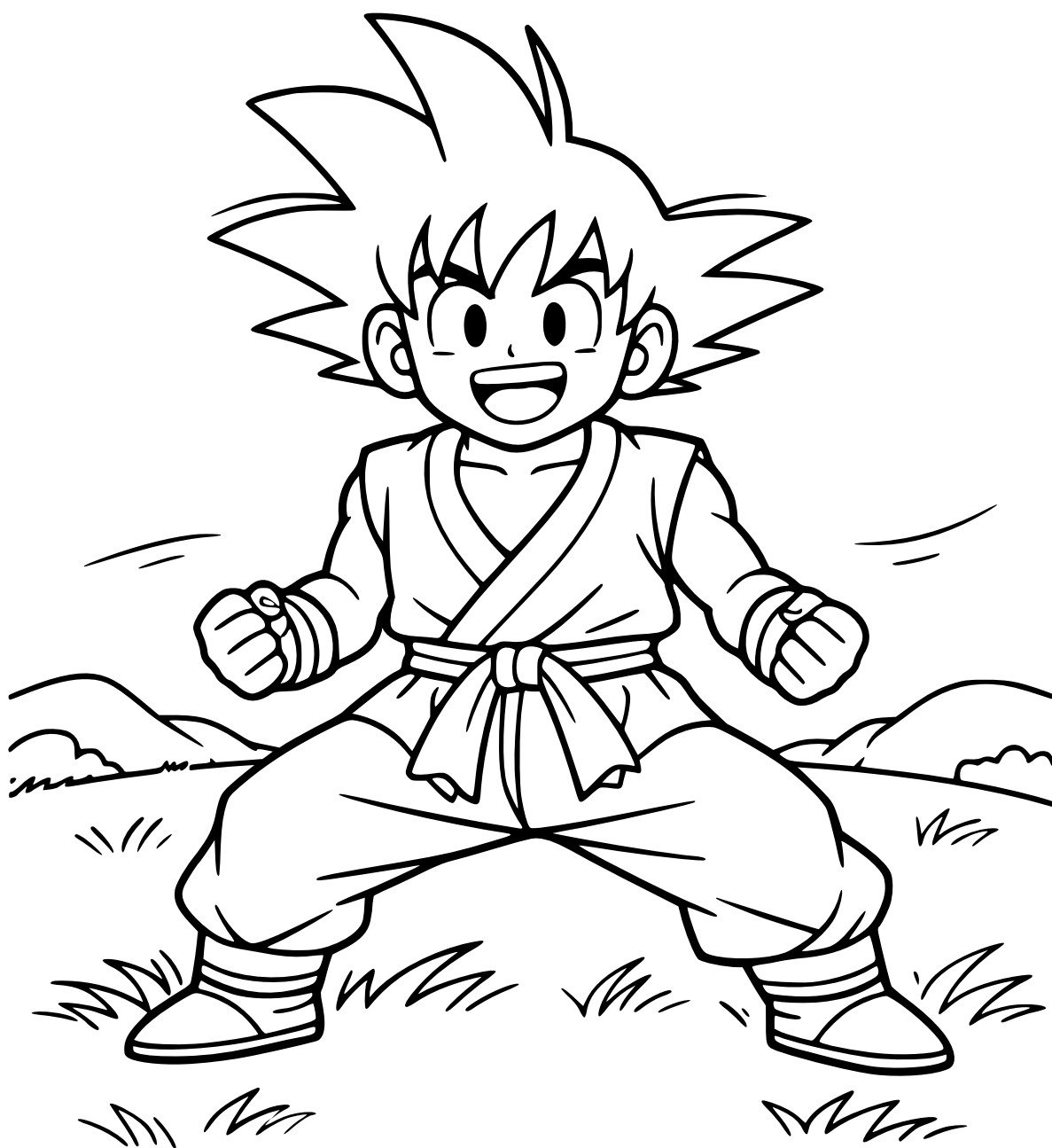

1. Goku's Ready Stance	7	12. Straight Punch	18
Goku plants both feet on a grassy hilltop in his orange gi, fists loose at his sides and a wide grin ready for whatever comes next.		Goku drives a straight punch right at you, burst lines radiating from his knuckles while his other arm stays coiled at his ribs.	
2. Golden Warrior Aura	8	13. Riding the Flying Cloud	19
Goku's hair stands straight up as a flame shaped aura swirls around him, his fists clenched and small stones lifting off the ground.		Goku sits cross legged on a small puffy flying cloud, one hand shading his eyes as the mountain peaks slide past far below.	
3. Perfectly Calm Power	9	14. Spinning the Power Pole	20
Goku stands utterly still with relaxed arms while ribbons of energy drift upward and his floating hair barely moves in the current.		Goku whips his long extending staff into a whirling circle above his head, the motion arcs drawing a perfect ring around him.	
4. Kid Goku and His Staff	10	15. The Wish Dragon Appears	21
A young Goku with a monkey tail perches on a rock, hugging his long staff across his knees while he waits for the next adventure.		A long serpentine wish dragon uncoils across the sky above the seven star marked orbs, its whiskers streaming and its mane bristling.	
5. Focused Blue Form	11	16. The Heavy Shell Hike	22
Goku holds a tight focused pose as a rippling ring of energy spreads out at his feet and cracks race across the stone beneath him.		Goku leans into a steep dirt path with an enormous turtle shell strapped to his back, tongue out and legs shaking on the climb.	
6. Weighted Training Gear	12	17. Waterfall Meditation	23
Goku shrugs a heavy weighted vest onto his shoulders among the boulders, sweat drops flying as he catches his breath between rounds.		Goku folds his legs on a flat rock beneath a crashing waterfall, eyes closed and palms up while the spray bursts around his shoulders.	
7. The Cupped Hands Beam	13	18. The Lookout Above the Clouds	24
Goku braces low with both palms cupped at his hip and lets a wide beam of energy roar out across the rocky canyon in front of him.		Goku steps to the rim of a round floating platform, a whole sea of clouds rolling far beneath his toes and no ground in sight.	
8. Flying Through the Clouds	14	19. Bowing in the Tournament Ring	25
One fist stretched forward, Goku tears through a sky of fat clouds with his gi rippling and a spiral of wind curling off his heels.		Goku bows politely at the edge of the square tournament ring, tall banners snapping overhead before the first round begins.	
9. Powering Up	15	20. Standing in the Crater	26
Goku crouches low and shouts with both arms bent tight while broken rocks, dust and loose pebbles lift and hang in the air around him.		Goku plants himself in the middle of a wide crater, cracked ground spreading in every direction and dust still hanging in the air.	
10. Martial Arts Guard	16	21. Inside the Training Chamber	27
Turned side on, Goku raises one open palm and pulls the other fist back, his bare feet gripping the cracked stone tiles of the floor.		Goku holds a one handed push up on the floor of a round domed training chamber, heavy weights stacked in a neat row beside him.	
11. High Spinning Kick	17	22. The Seven Star Orbs	28
Goku snaps a high spinning kick in mid air, a long curved motion trail sweeping behind his leg above the empty rocky plain.		Seven round crystal orbs rest in a wide circle on the grass, star shapes glinting inside the glass and little sparkles floating between them.	

23. The Four Star Orb	29
One large crystal orb with four stars inside sits on a folded cloth, sparkle marks scattered around its curved and shining surface.	
24. Radar and Capsules	30
A round handheld tracker with a blinking screen lies on a workbench beside two little cylinder capsules waiting to be thrown.	
25. The Uniform Laid Out	31
The orange training uniform lies folded and ready with its blue sash coiled on top, wristbands to one side and boots set neatly below.	
26. Chibi Goku	32
A tiny chibi Goku with a giant head and round shining eyes throws a happy thumbs up, his spiky hair almost bigger than his body.	
27. Three Panel Comic Page	33
Three clean comic panels follow Goku as he runs, launches into the air and lands hard, speed lines streaking across every frame.	
28. Star Orb Mandala	34
Star marked orbs, curling flame shapes and repeating petals wind out from the centre of this round mandala in perfect symmetry.	
29. Eight Bit Pixel Goku	35
Goku rebuilt from big square blocks on a grid, an eight bit portrait you color one pixel at a time like a piece of cross stitch.	
30. Extra Easy Goku	36
A big smiling Goku face drawn with extra thick outlines and only a handful of large shapes, made for the smallest hands in the house.	



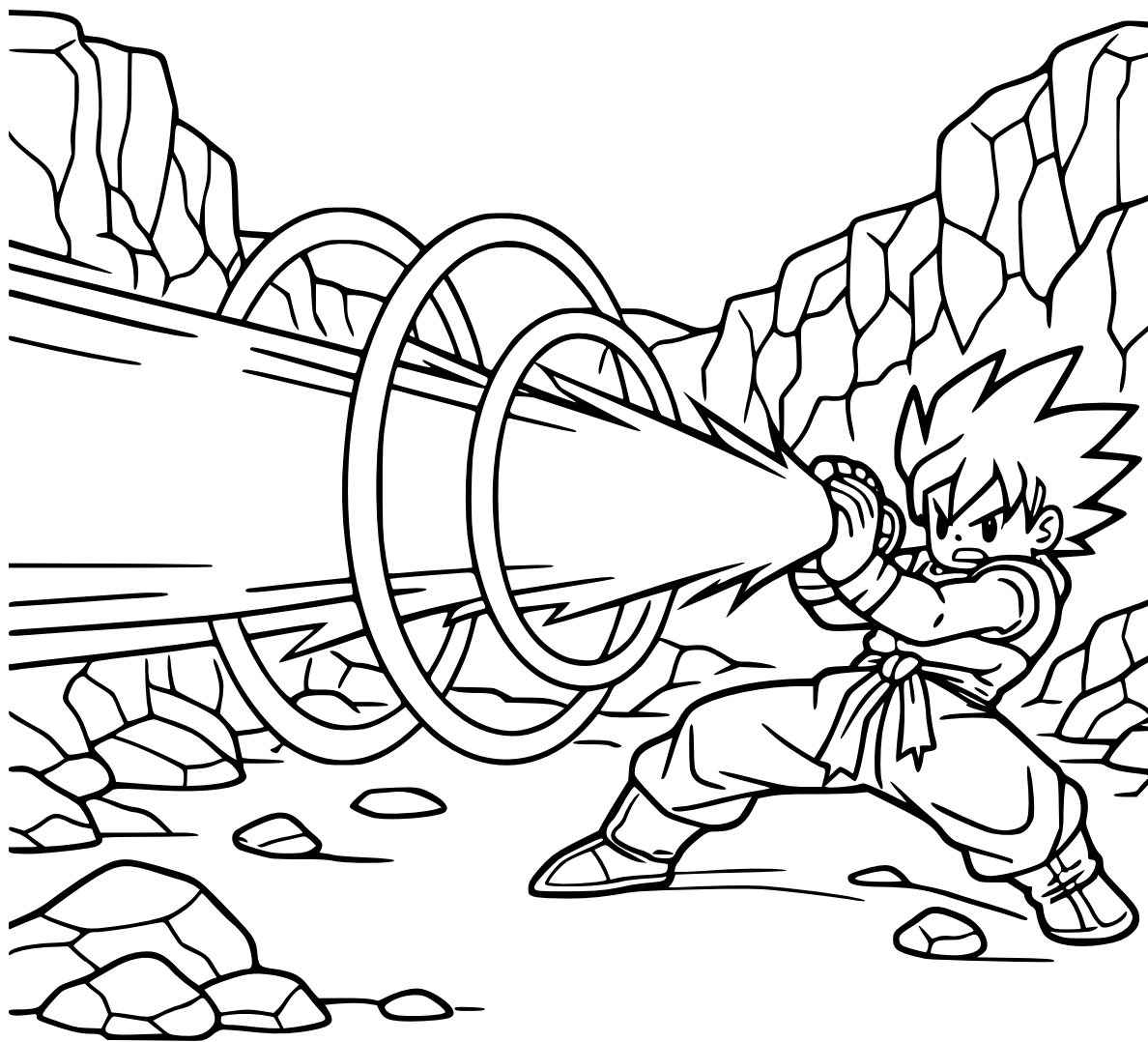




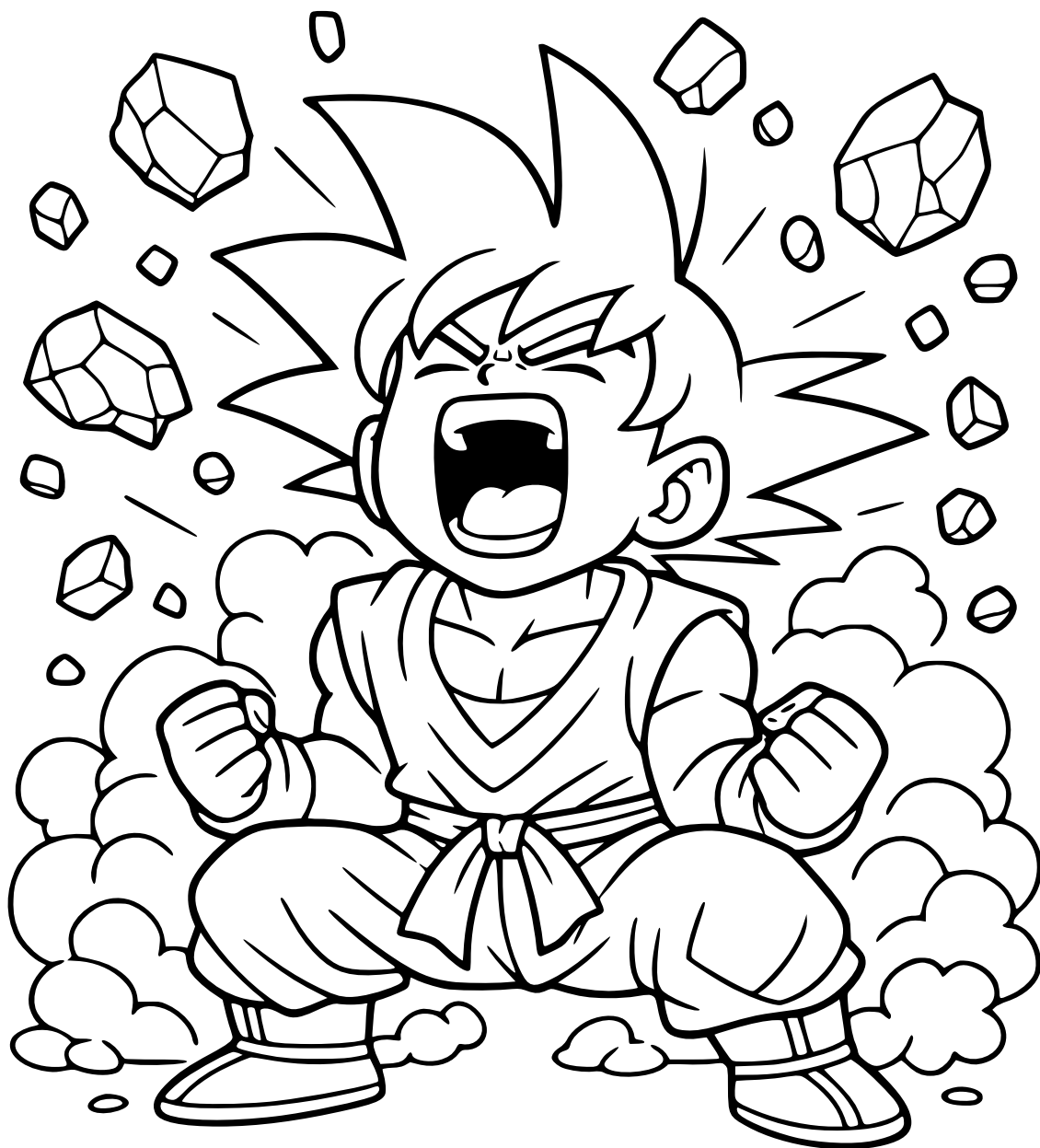






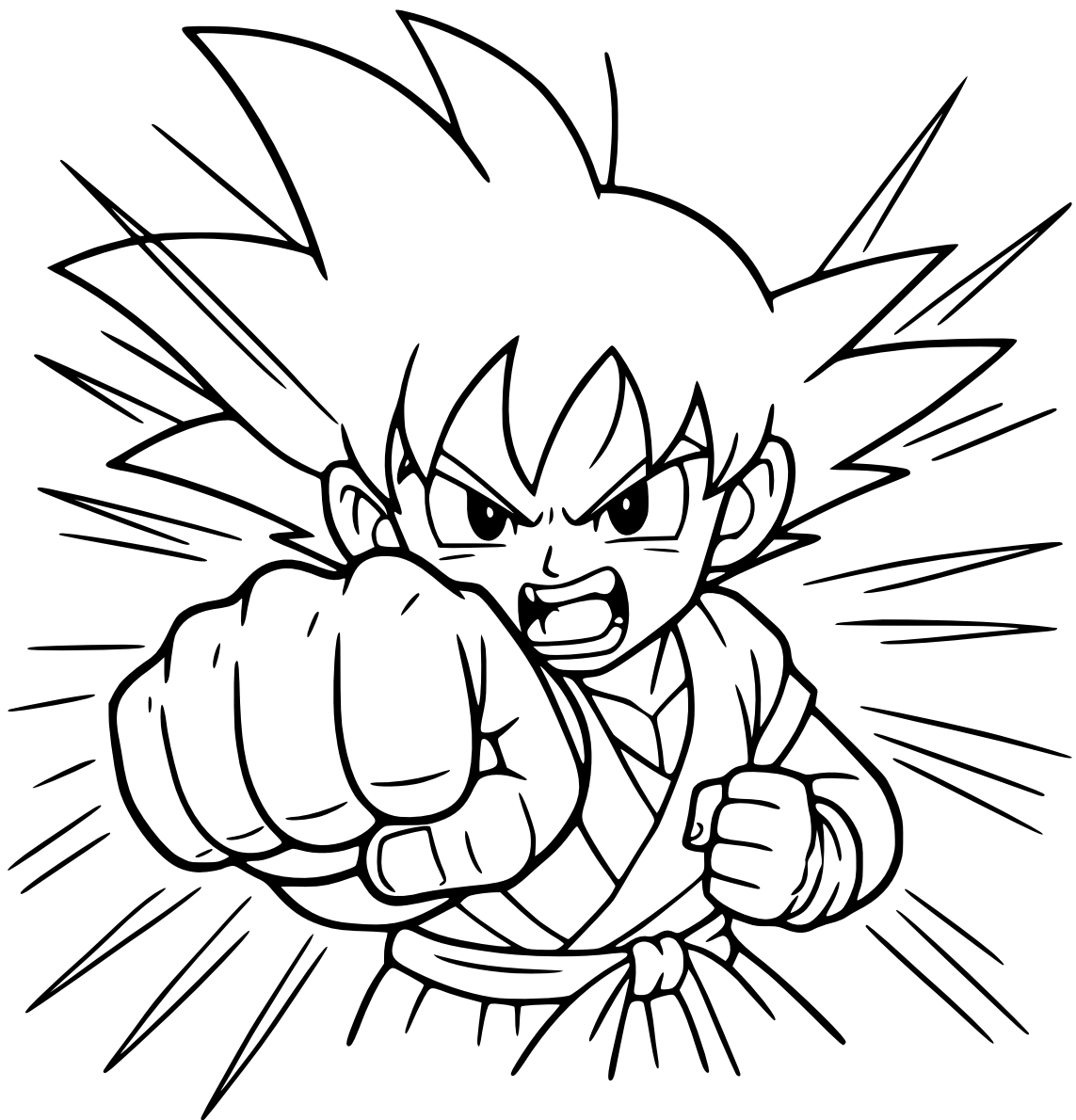










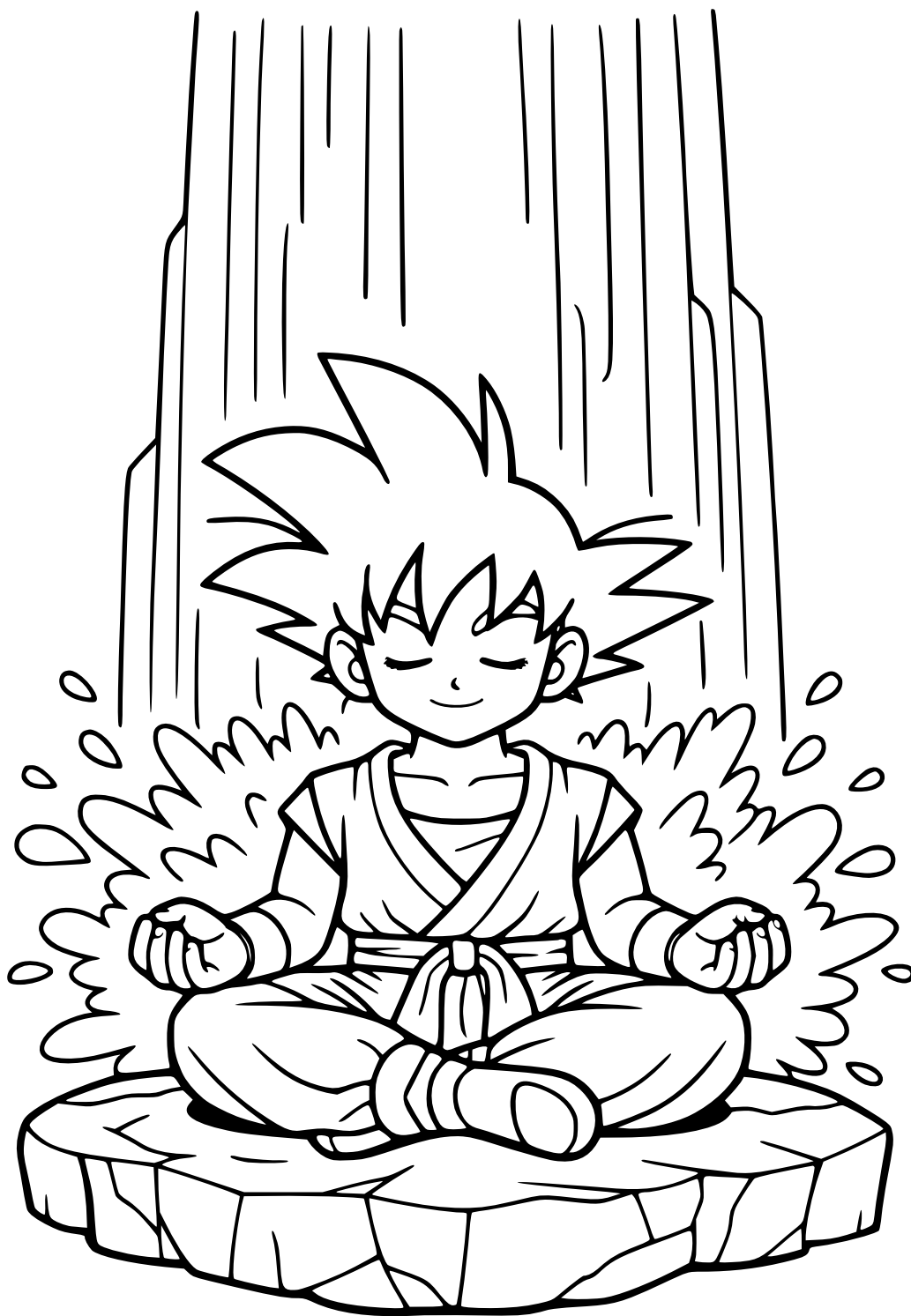


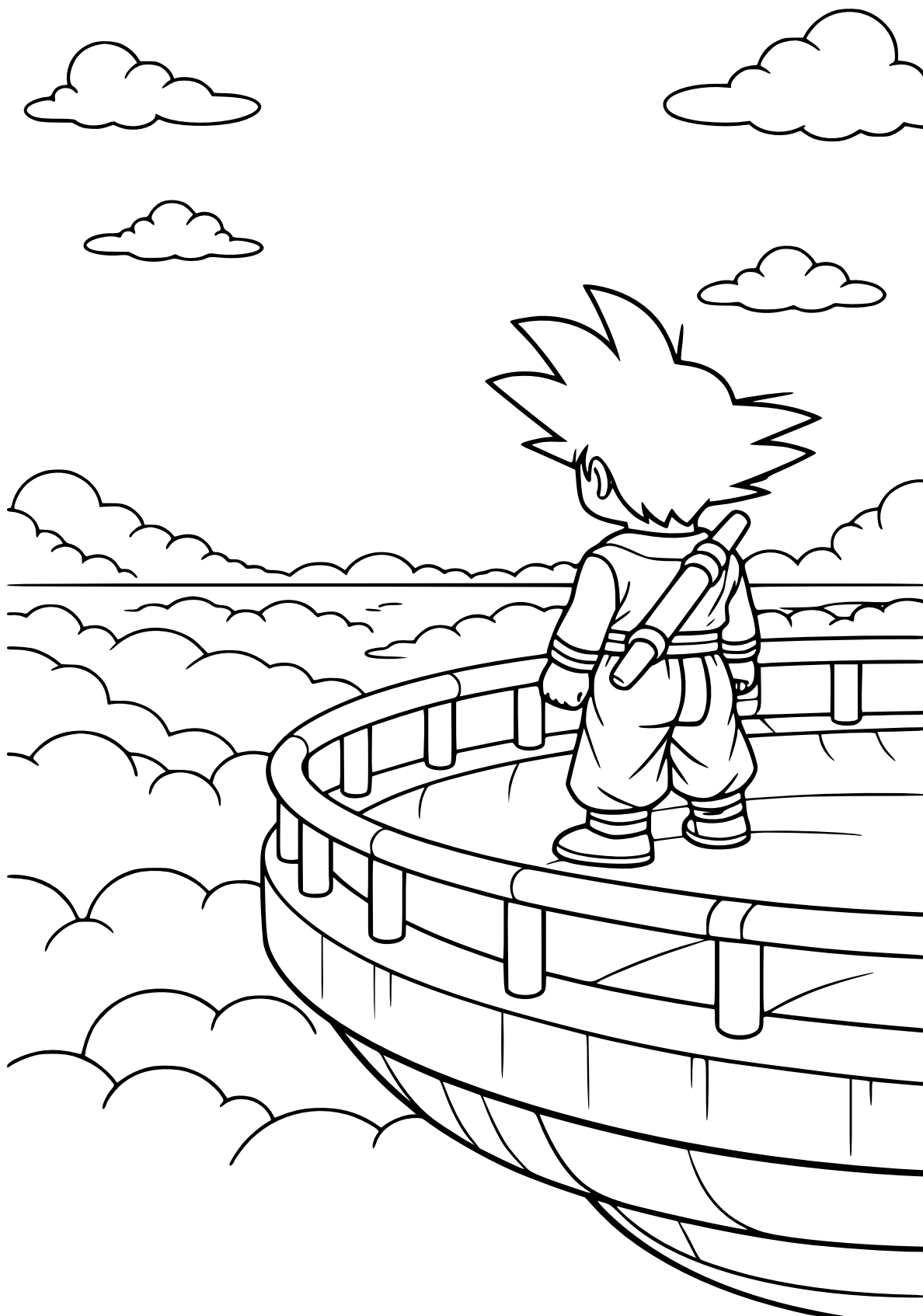


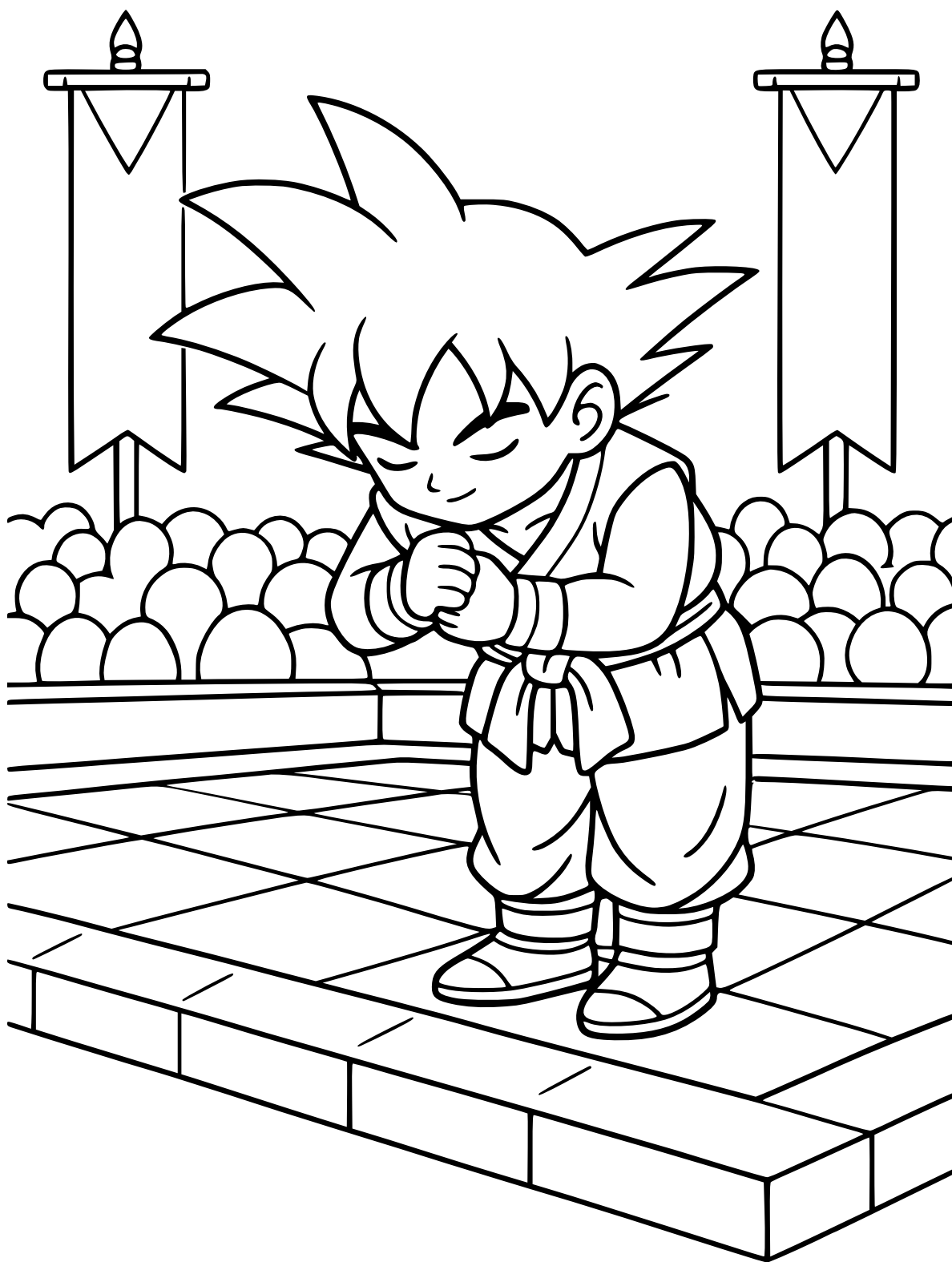


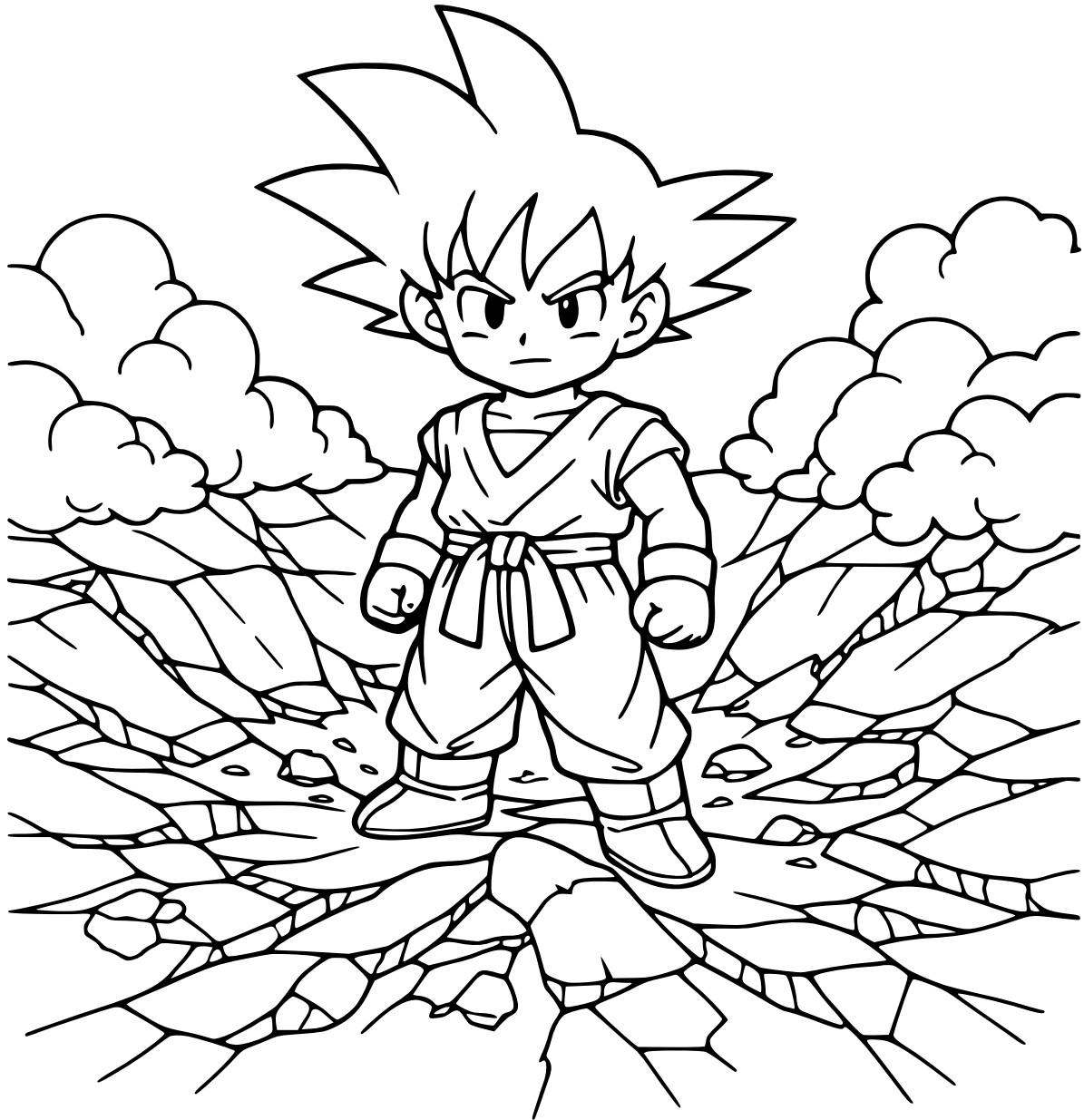




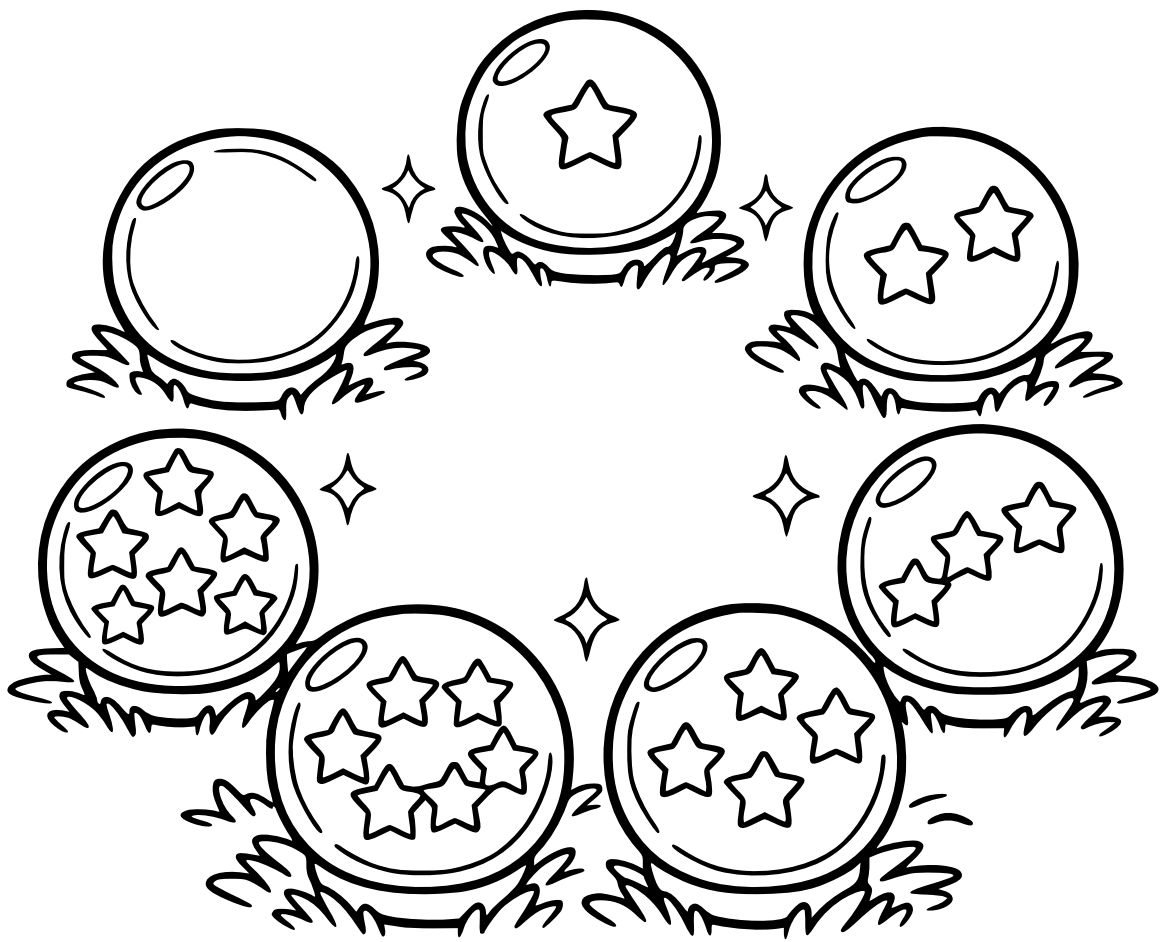




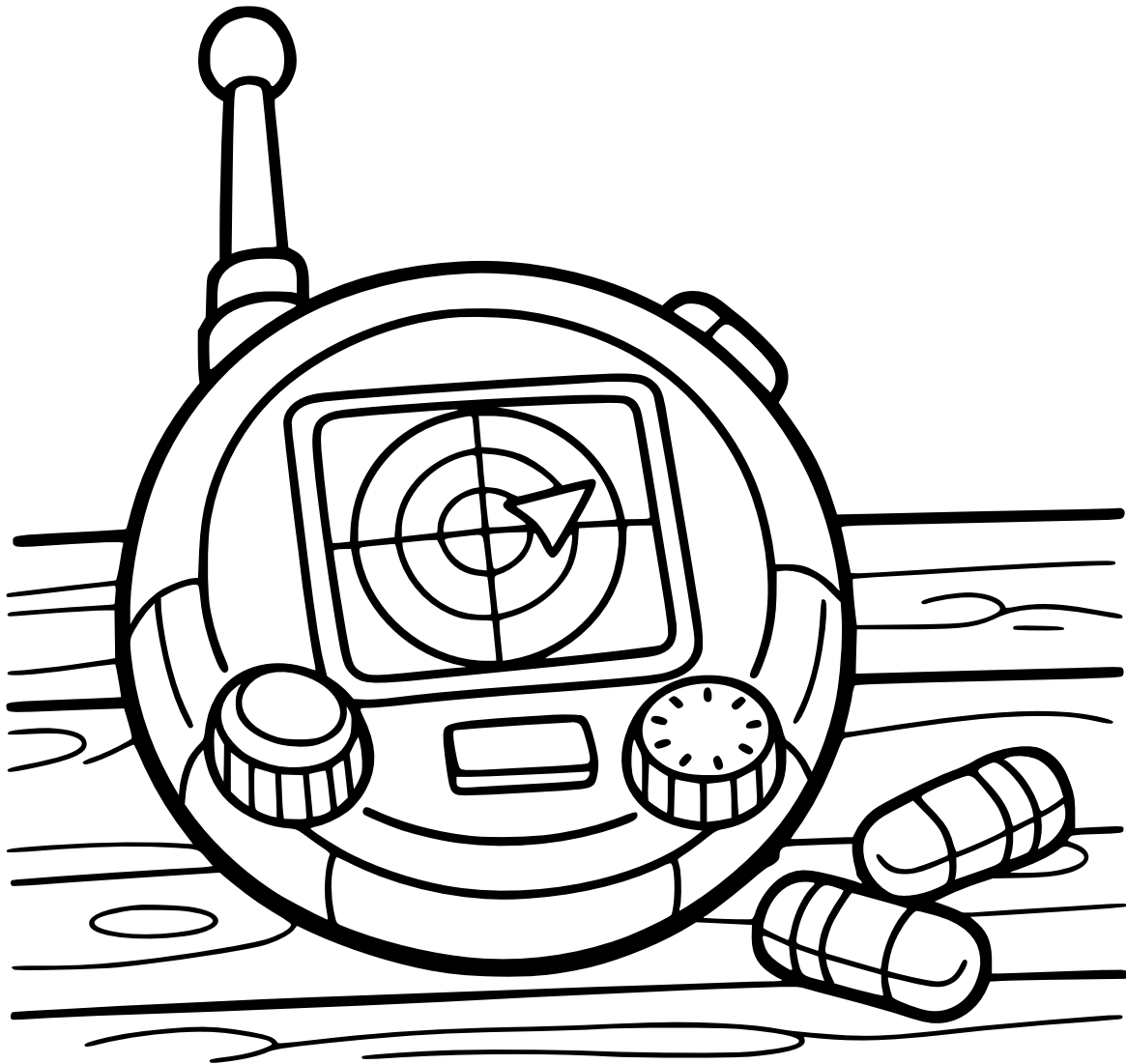


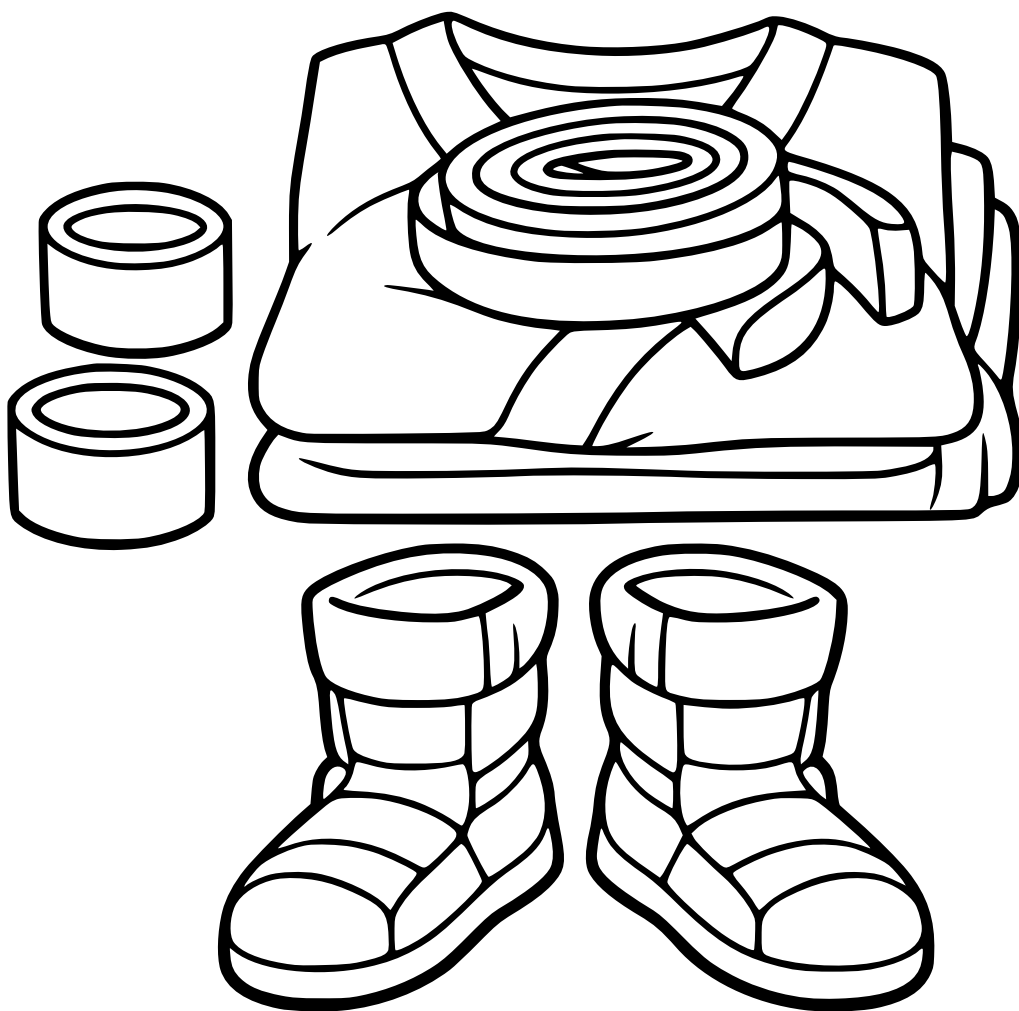




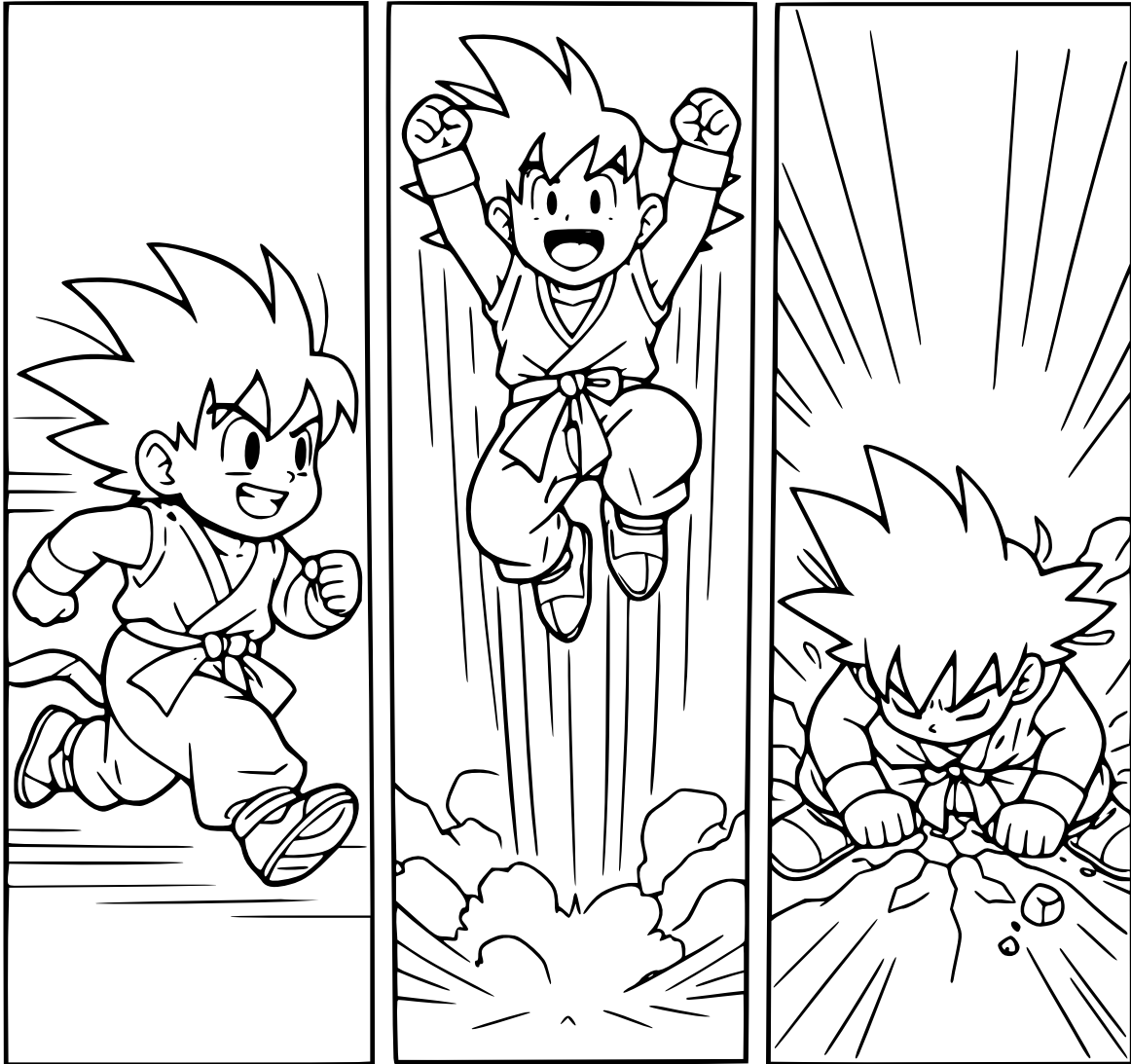


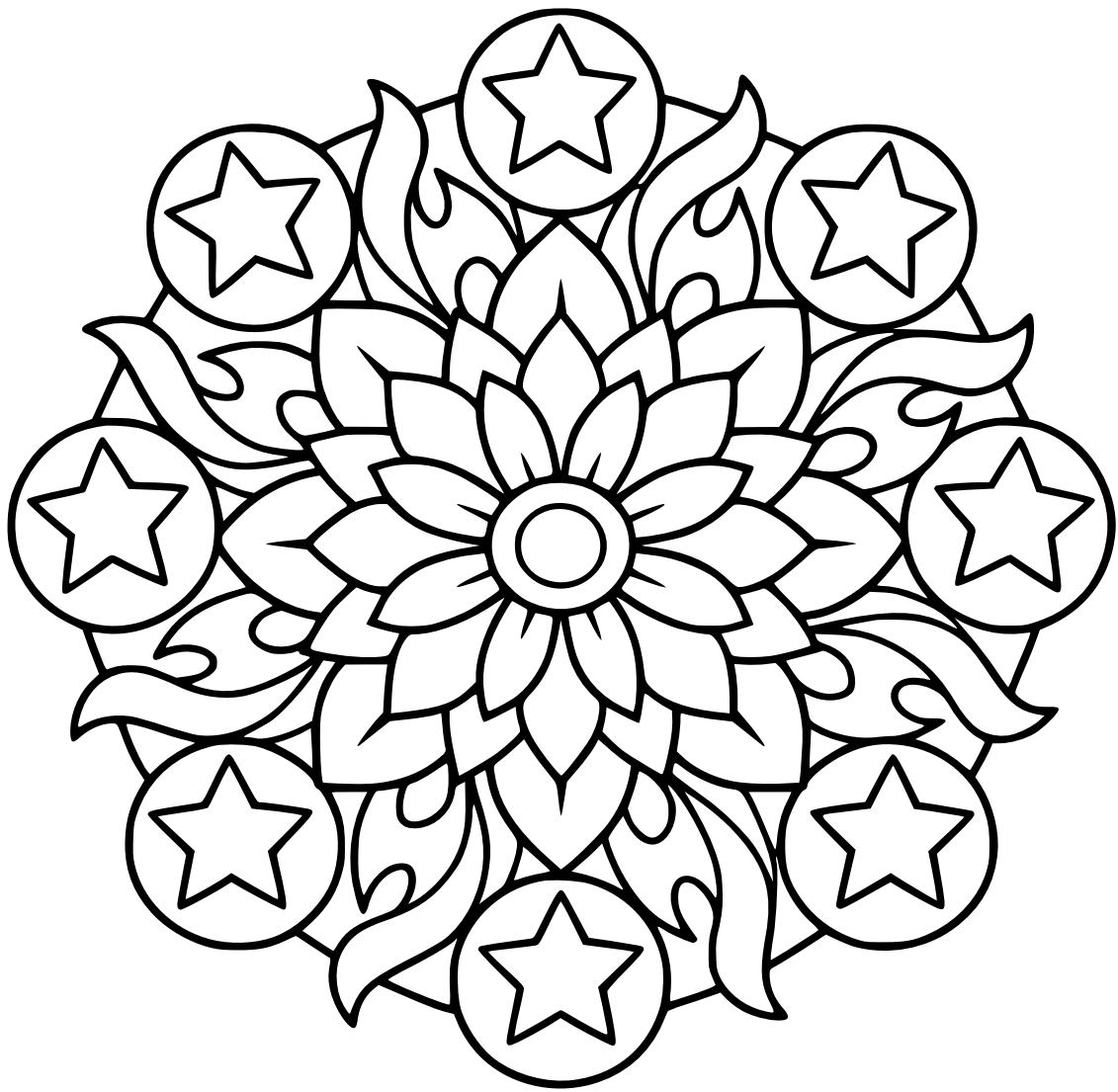


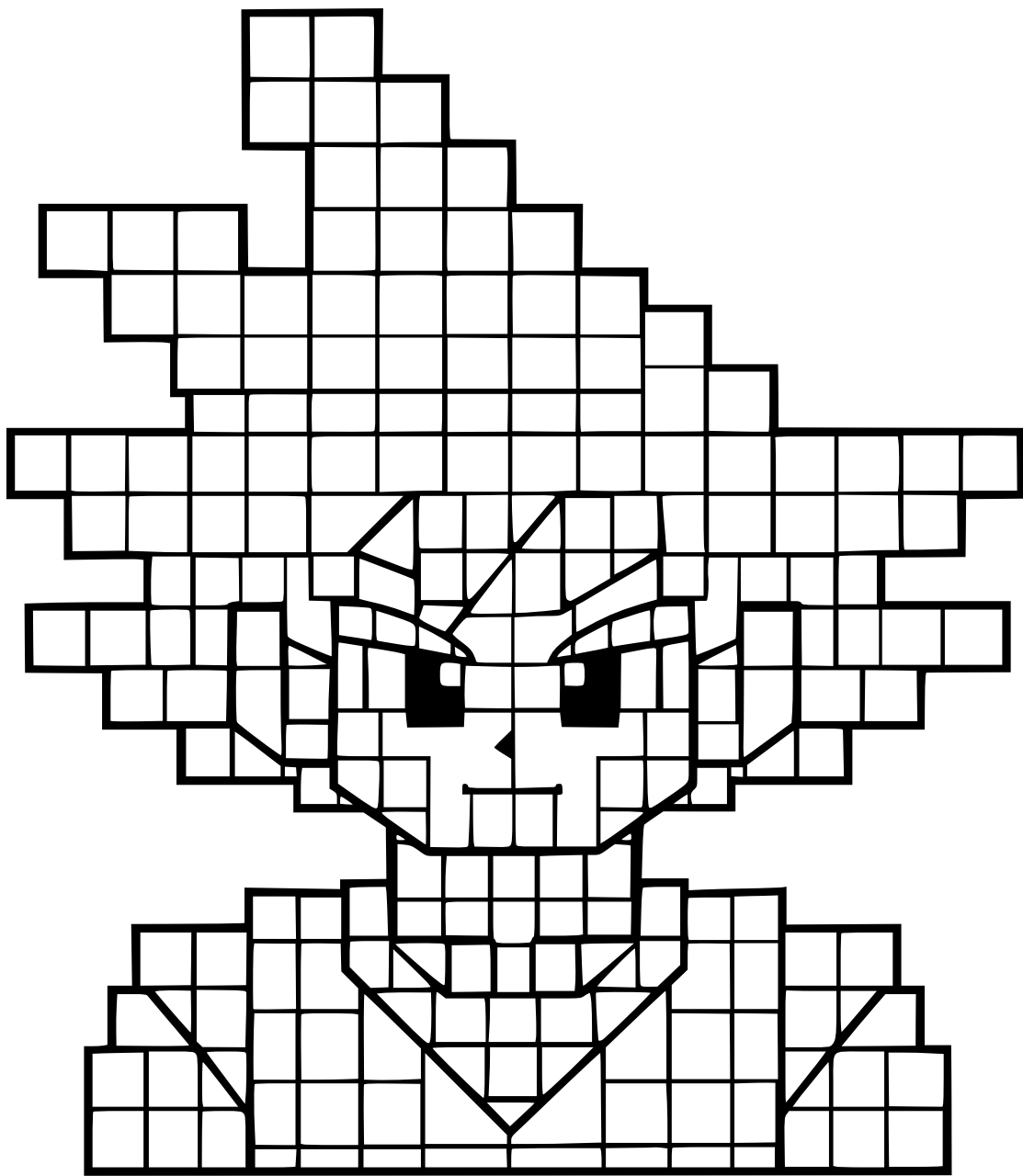


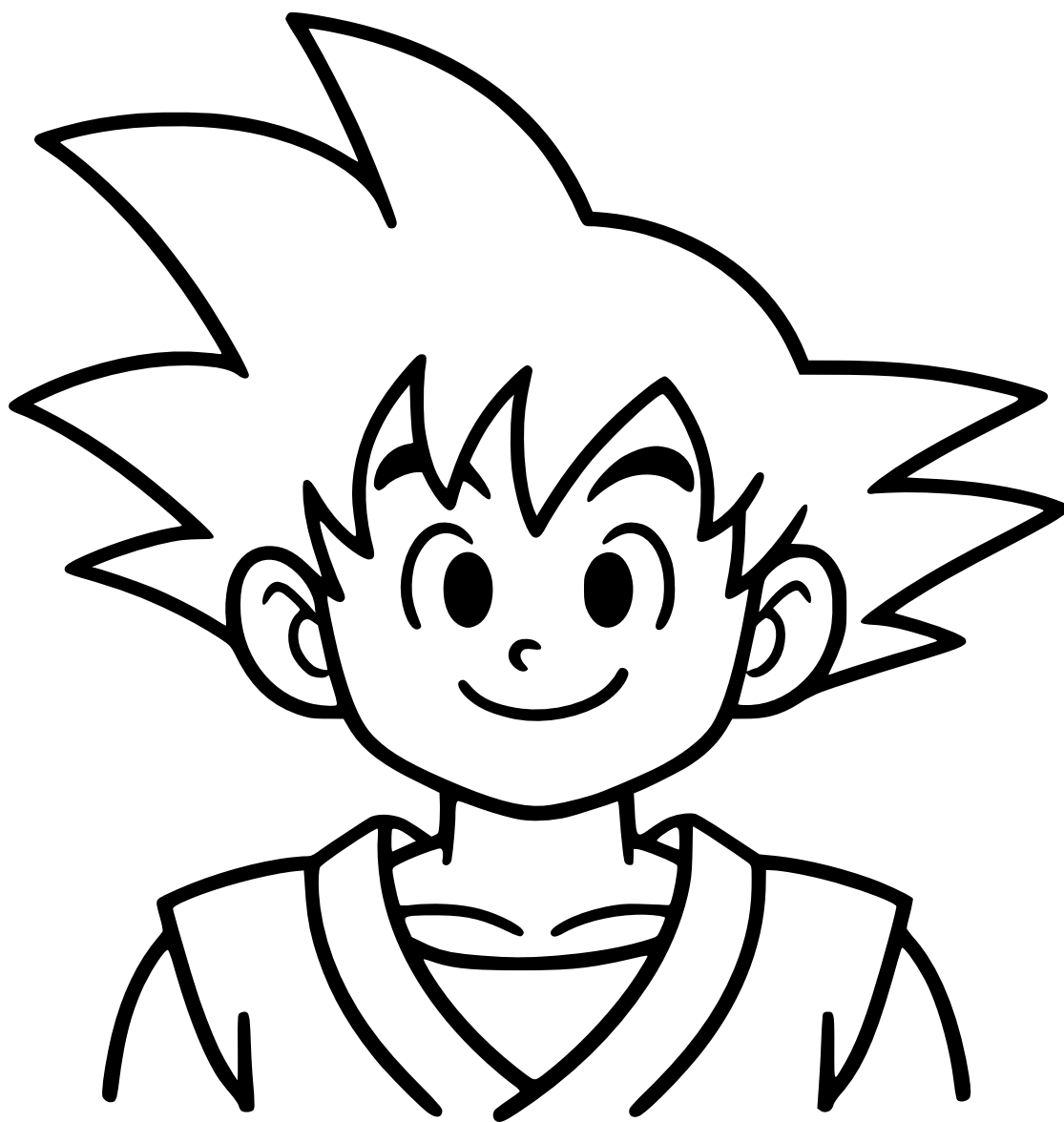
