About this collection

Our free Halloween coloring pages bring the friendliest side of spooky season to paper: grinning jack-o-lanterns, kind little witches, ghosts that would rather wave than scare, and a skeleton who only wants to dance. Every drawing is original art with bold outlines and big open areas, easy for small hands and satisfying for grown-ups too. Download any page instantly as a crisp vector PDF for Letter or A4 paper, free, with no sign-up and no watermarks, or color it online right in your browser. They are perfect for October classrooms, party tables and rainy autumn afternoons. Print a stack, grab the orange and purple crayons, and let the whole family decorate the fridge before the big night.

Tips for coloring Halloween pages

The classic Halloween palette is orange, purple, green and black, and it never fails. A fun trick: leave the moon and the ghosts white and color everything around them in deep night tones, so they seem to glow. Metallic or neon pens look spectacular on the candy and the stars, and a touch of yellow behind windows turns any haunted house instantly alive.

From coloring page to Halloween decoration

These pages are decorations in disguise. Cut out the finished pumpkins and ghosts and tape them to windows, string several drawings together as a garland, or use colored pages as place mats for the party table. Print on slightly heavier paper and the cut-outs survive the whole season.

Frequently asked questions

Are these pages too scary for little kids?

No. Every character is drawn on the friendly side of spooky: smiling pumpkins, waving ghosts and a very polite vampire. The designs suit colorists from about age three.

Can I print them for a classroom or a party?

Yes. Print as many copies as you need for home, classroom or party use. Each page downloads as a clean vector PDF that prints sharp every time.

Can I color them online?

Yes. Every drawing has a Color online button that opens our browser coloring studio, no app needed. It works like a free online coloring game: tap an area, pick a color, done.

How to print

Every page is sized for US Letter and prints on A4 without cropping if you set your printer to "fit to page". Print single-sided so colors do not show through, and use cardstock if you plan to use markers. There are no watermarks and no sign-up, on any page.

Terms of use

Free for personal, classroom and library use. Print as many copies as you need. Please do not re-sell these pages or re-host the file: link to the collection page instead, so the book stays up to date.

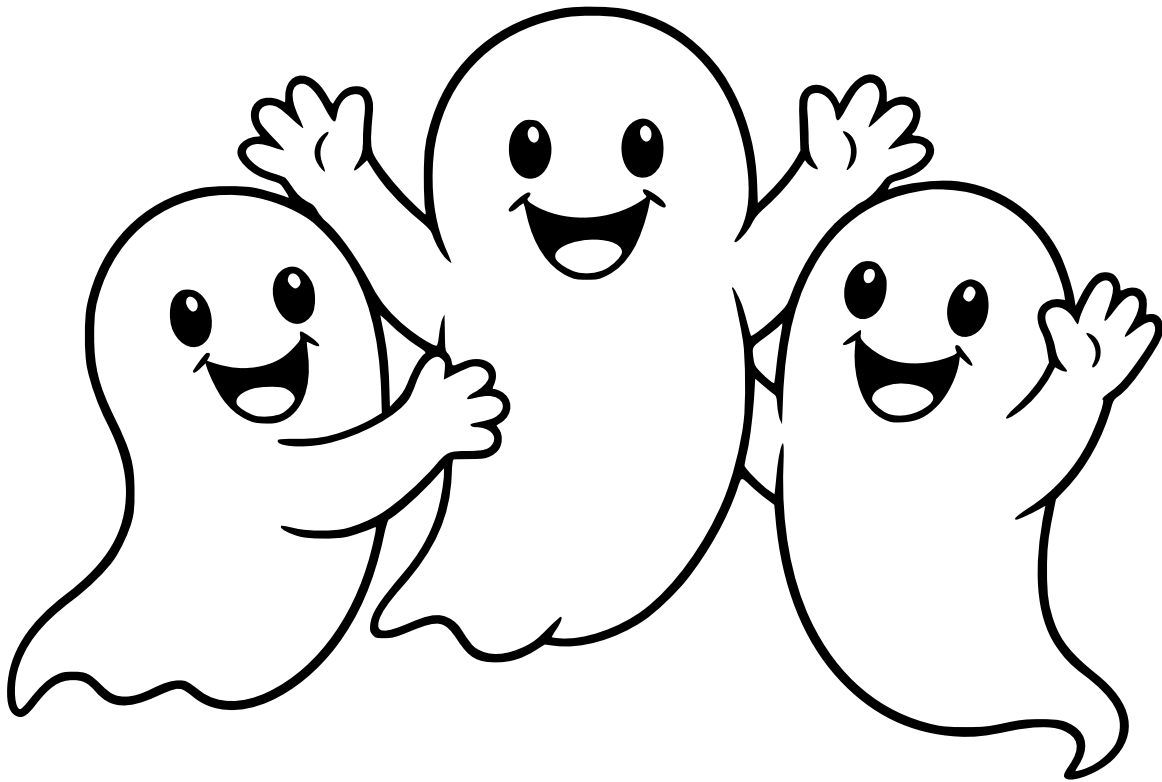
