About this collection

Welcome to our Rapunzel coloring pages: a big collection of free printable designs from the classic fairy tale, each one ready to download as a high quality PDF and print at home in seconds. No sign up, no watermarks: pick a page, press Download PDF, and you are coloring within a minute. Every drawing is original artwork in our own storybook line style, sized for Letter and A4 paper, with bold, clear outlines that small hands can follow. You will find Rapunzel letting her long braid down from the tower window, weaving flowers into it in the meadow, reading in her cozy tower room, playing with a kitten and watching the stars, plus extra easy designs for toddlers and intricate patterned braids for older artists. No printer? Every design can also be colored online right in your browser.

Where can you print free Rapunzel coloring pages?

Right here, free and in about a minute. This page gathers 40 printable Rapunzel coloring pages drawn in our own classic storybook style, each one a high quality PDF sized for US Letter and A4 paper. There is no sign up and no watermark, and every design can also be colored online in your browser.

The fairy tale behind these pages

Rapunzel is the girl from the classic Brothers Grimm fairy tale, famous for the tall stone tower and the impossibly long braid she lets down from her window. Every drawing here comes from that storybook world and is drawn in our own studio line style: the tower in the forest clearing, the braid woven full of flowers, the songbirds, the kitten and a starry night at the tower window. You will not find scenes copied from any film here, only the tale as picture books have told it for two hundred years.

Coloring ideas for Rapunzel's world

The braid is the star, so give it a rich golden yellow and a few brighter highlights so it shines against the gray stones of the tower. Storybook dresses look lovely in soft rose, sky blue or spring green, and the flowers woven into the braid are your chance to use every bright color in the box. For the tower, try warm grays and sandy browns with ivy green climbing the walls, and leave the sky pale blue by day or deep indigo with golden stars for the night scene. Markers need thicker paper (cardstock) so they do not bleed through; crayons and pencils are happy on plain printer paper.

The best page for every age

Toddlers should start with Easy Rapunzel: extra thick lines, one big friendly face, nothing fiddly. Kids from about four to eight usually go straight for the tower window, the kitten and the tree swing. Older kids and grown-ups tend to pick the patterned braid, which colors like a mandala and can fill a whole quiet evening. Planning a fairy tale party? Print a stack of the forest picnic page and let every guest color their own.

Frequently asked questions

Are these Rapunzel pages free for schools?

Yes. Everything here is free for personal use and for classrooms, libraries and therapy practices. The details are in our licensing policy.

What paper size do the PDFs fit?

Every PDF is built for both US Letter and A4. Choose "fit to page" in your print dialog and you are set. There are more tips in our how-to-print guide.

Can we color Rapunzel online without a printer?

Yes. Every design has a "Color online" button that opens it in our browser coloring studio. Paint with a mouse or a finger, undo anything you like, and download the finished picture as a PDF or a PNG.

Who draws these pages?

We do. Every design is original artwork in our house line style, drawn from the fairy tale itself rather than from anyone else's pictures. If you like this collection, the rest of our fantasy coloring pages are drawn the same way.

More fairy tale coloring

If towers and braids won you over, our princess coloring pages add ball gowns, castles and a royal tea party to the story shelf. Our Cinderella coloring pages continue the storybook shelf with the pumpkin carriage and the glass slipper. And when you want the whole magical bookcase in one place, our fantasy coloring pages hub gathers unicorns, dragons and every new arrival first.

How to print

Every page is sized for US Letter and prints on A4 without cropping if you set your printer to "fit to page". Print single-sided so colors do not show through, and use cardstock if you plan to use markers. There are no watermarks and no sign-up, on any page.

Terms of use

Free for personal, classroom and library use. Print as many copies as you need. Please do not re-sell these pages or re-host the file: link to the collection page instead, so the book stays up to date.
